HISTORY

Silvia Cellars takes its inspiration from our Italian wine producing family heritage. Our mission is to produce a small number of high quality California wines from some of California's best vineyards. We have dedicated ourselves to making delicious, handcrafted wines from some of the finest appellations on the West Coast: California (Napa Valley, Sonoma County, Mendocino County, Amador County and Paso Robles). We take pride and joy in working hard to produce premium quality wines.

GROWING SEASON

The 2020 growing season was mild to moderate overall, with bud break and flowering occurring a week earlier than in 2019, and more spring frost events than typical. Most of our fruit come from Mendocino County, which saw some impacts from the recent wildfires, with certain sub-appellations more affected by smoke than others. Even so, smoke impacts were very low, considering the size and duration of the fires. In spite of the challenges, overall quality is very good, especially for whites. The region's major varieties performed well, particularly Chardonnay. The fruit quality for 2020 ranges was outstanding.

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

This wine was fermented in 100% in stainless steel tanks. The wine is refreshing with flavors of citrus, like tangerine and lemon. The rich, round entry rolls into a viscous and silky mouth-feel, surrounded by asian pears and Honey-crisp apples. The finish lingers long and soft, a touch of acidity extends the finish with long mineral felling. This versatile wine pairs well with grilled fish, roasted vegetable fresh green salads, and soft, mild cheeses. Enjoy this gem SALUTE!
