HISTORY

GROWING SEASON

Following a wet spring, bud break occurred later than normal. Bloom was delayed, with some rain and high humidity occurring during that period. Optimal temperatures for powdery mildew led to high pressure, but growers kept on top of the situation. The weather remained fairly moderate through most of the season, canopies were healthy, and the fruit ripened at a fairly predictable rate. Harvest timing was average, and yields came in light to normal. The 2019 harvest for our Cabernet Sauvignon was good with excellent fruit quality.

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

Continuing the Silvia Cellars tradition and style of wine-making, this wine is a blend of the best Cabernet Sauvignons in our North Coast vineyards coming from our growers of Mendocino Valley, Alexander Valley and Napa Valley. The 2019 was blended with a splash of Syrah and Petit Verdot. The nose as a touch of plum and a touch of dark mocha. On the palate, layers of soft tannins with light oak presence. This wine is fruity and elegant with a vibrant long mouth-feel. The finish is long with good structure. This wine will pair with everything from pasta, vegan dishes or classic meats.
